


Before the Indian Wells Tennis Tournament pictures, I have a few pictures that I took when we were at the Melbourne Tennis Center in February 2014.


Carolyn getting fresh with 'Rocket' Rod Laver. He wasn't called The Rocket for nothing.




Carolyn standing in the Hall of Champions, near three of her favorite tennis players.

Interesting sign that points to various tennis destinations.




That concludes the Melbourne portion of the program.

This is one of the smaller stadiums. What a beautiful view.




Roger Federer on a practice court, late in the day.





Roger Federer.

I think this is Vera Zvonareva, but I could be wrong.




Dinara Safina retired at the age of 26, after having made more than \$10,000,000 playing tennis. She always seemed to be a bit of a head case.

Bartoli retired at the age of 28, after having made more than \$11,000,000 playing tennis.






Marion Bartoli on a practice court. Note the giant elastic bands around her ankles.
